SUSTAINABILITY CHARTER

At Le Chamarel Restaurant, we are committed to make sustainability and inclusiveness part of our brand identity. We continuously go the extra mile to integrate sustainability in our daily operations.



CLIMATE:

Set a target and migrate towards zero carbon



We are committed to reduce our carbon footprint through:

- Monitoring our energy consumption
- Use of LED lights throughout the restaurant premises
- Full adherence to green building practices and optimal use of natural ventilation
- Priority for recruitment from the region
- Installation of pressure-regulating valves to conserve water resources



BIODIVERSITY:

Preserve and protect the local species on both land and at sea



We believe in a paradise turned towards the future and existing for the generations to come. We:

- Regularly engage in Clean-Up actions together with local associations (such as Spirit of Chamarel) and the Village Council
- We propagate plants for the embellishment of the streetscape in Chamarel village
- Use organic and environment-friendly products for landscaping



CIRCULAR ECONOMY:

Reduce waste production and recycle more than 75% of waste produced



We are committed to handle and reduce our waste going to landfill:

- Plastic water bottles and single-use plastic have been banned in our operations; representing 7,500 plastic water bottles in the year 2019 - 2020. Eco-friendly paper straws have replaced plastic straws
- We have in place a selective waste sorting procedure; glass bottles are collected and recycled at Plankton. There is a dedicated bin for paper recycling
- Surplus foodstuff is distributed to inhabitants of Chamarel for farming
- Green waste from our kitchen is composted and used as natural fertilizer for our herb garden
- We recycle our wastewater for irrigation purposes
- Used oil from the kitchen is collected weekly by Bioil Ltd for recycling into second-generation biofuels



VIBRANT COMMUNITIES:

Work towards proactive integration of local communities, responsible development with more sustainable building practices



Our wish is to be an active contributor in establishing the region of Chamarel as a vibrant haven with and for our community.

- We promote terroir products and delight taste buds of customers by giving them the best of the authentic Mauritian creole cuisine
- We celebrate the history of the region and support the village council of Chamarel along with the association Spirit of Chamarel
- We promote the uniqueness of the region and the know-how of its inhabitants daily. For example, we emphasise the authenticity of the prestigious Café de Chamarel – the only coffee grown, harvested, roasted and commercialised in Mauritius



INCLUSIVE DEVELOPMENT:

We ensure that our business contributes actively to the economic development of the region:

- Priority is given to inhabitants of the region for recruitment
- We partner with local producers to promote their products in our Restaurant and Retail corner such as the Palm Heart which is grown in Chamarel and the locally grown and roasted Café de Chamarel.

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
